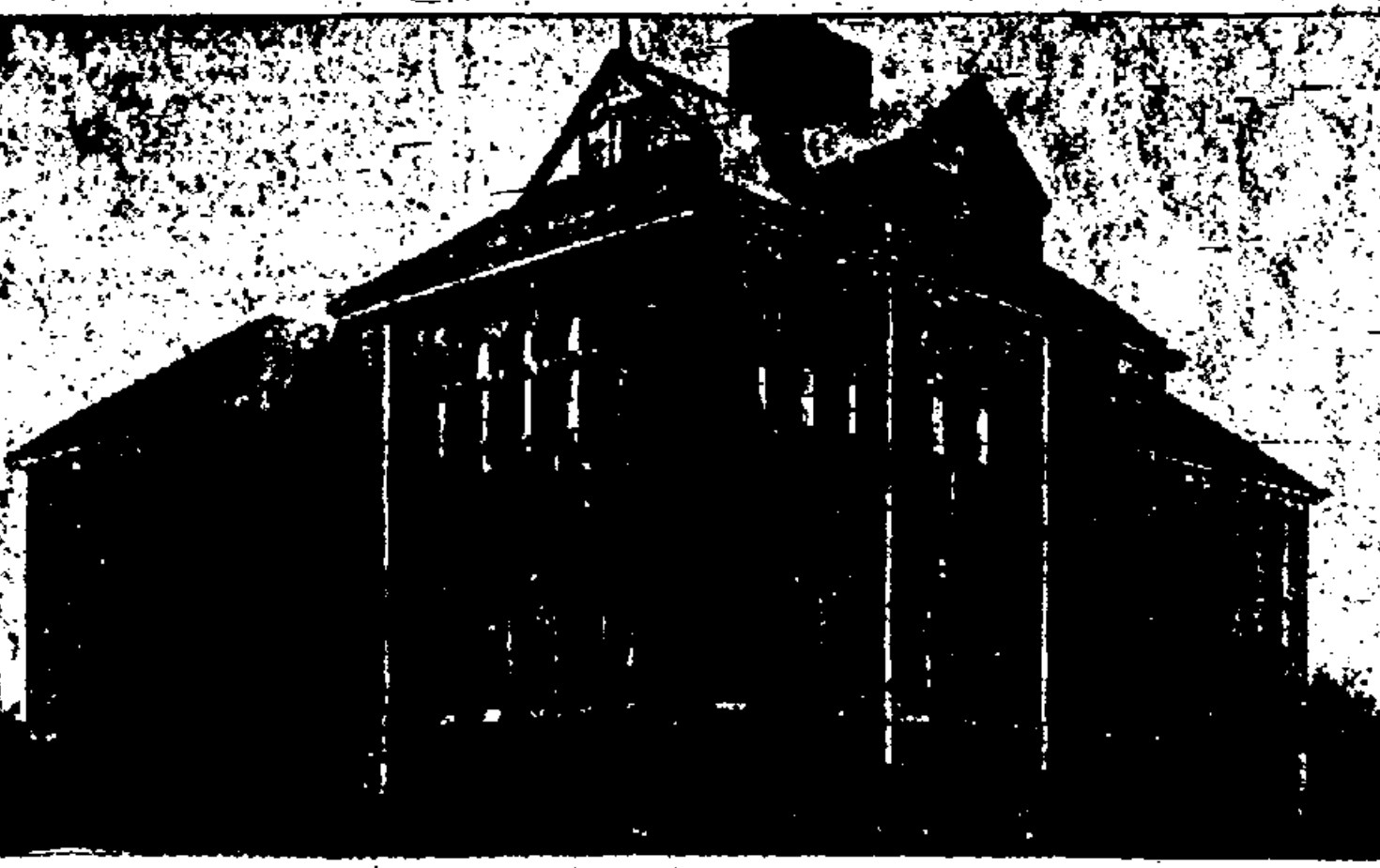


Elizabeth T. Carney Has Unique Task in Educational System
